Bible Studies

What is the Gospel?

A three part series looking at what is the Gospel?

What is the gospel of Jesus Christ? You would think that is an easy question to answer- especially for a Christian. So why is it that when prompted to answer such a question we fall short of the answer the Bible holds out as the gospel of Christ? The fact is getting Christians to agree on what is the gospel is not as simple as it should be.

Is it, that God will forgive your sins if you believe in Him? Or that God loves you and has a wonderful plan for your life? Or the gospel is that you are a child of God and God wants you to be abundantly successful in all we do? Some would know that it is important to say something about Jesus death on the cross and his resurrection, but how does it all fit together?

This three part series is designed to teach you the gospel so that as the glorious truth of the Bible hits you- it causes your heart to swell with joy and praise towards Jesus for what he has accomplished for you. The more we understand of the gospel, the more we believe it, rely on it and adore God for who he is and what he has done in Christ.

I hope it will give us a deeper confidence to share the good news of Jesus Christ, and that we will see the importance of the gospel in the local church, that we will make sure this gospel, is preached, sung, prayed, taught and proclaimed in every aspect of the life of this church.

And finally I hope this series will make you think about the good news of Christ. This is the message that we stake our entire lives on as Christians, and it is a message that demands a response- if there is anything we cannot afford to ignore it is the "good news."
